## As a new hire, where do I *assume* I can find information?

Linking to onboarding guides is not enough to assume accessibility. Information overload is both common and likely in first 1-5 days, and links are easily lost or forgotten.

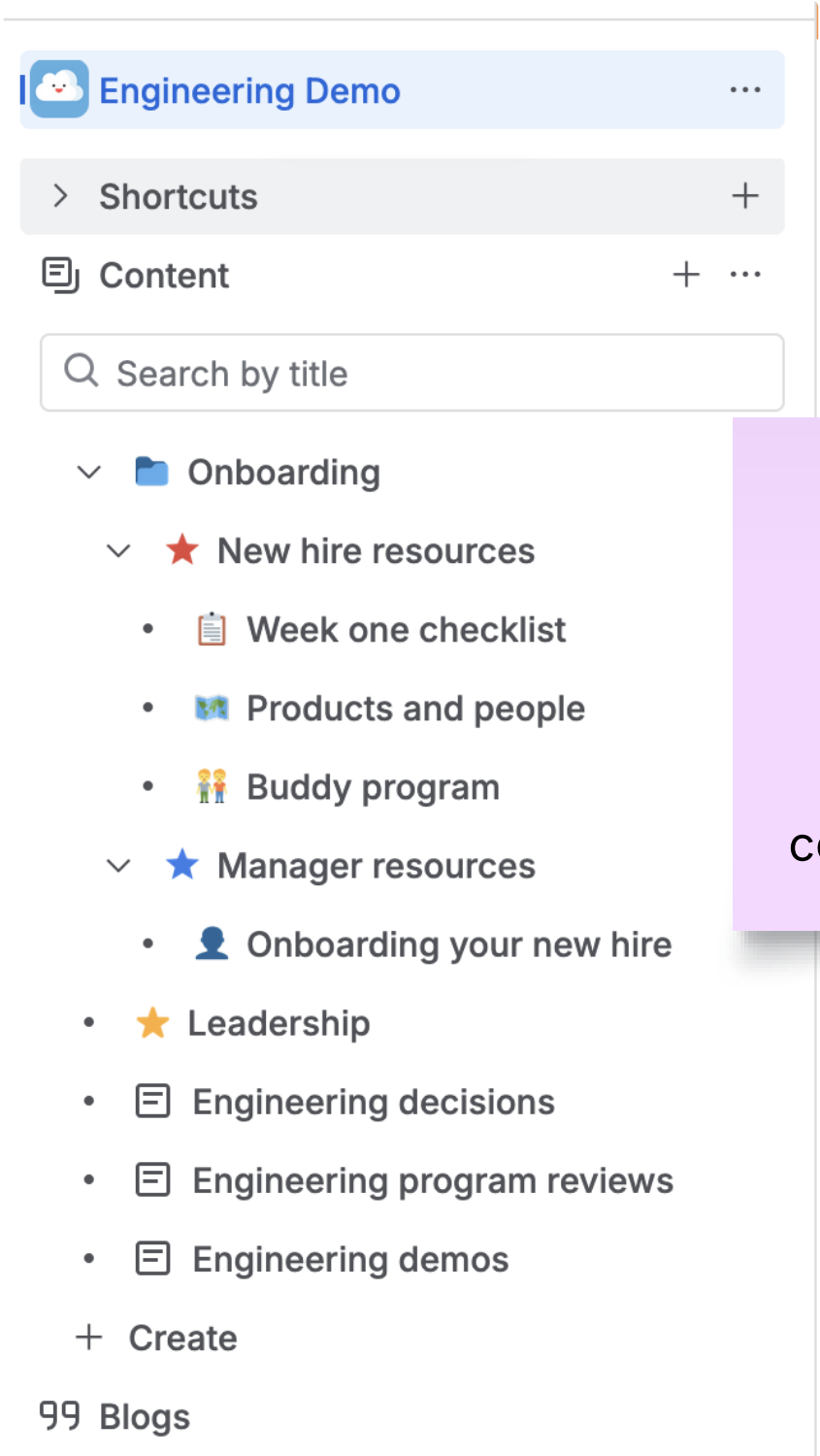
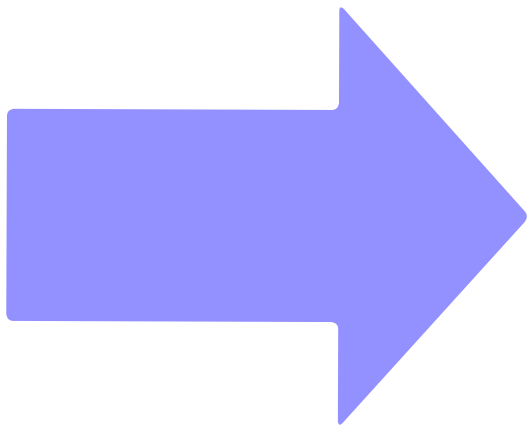
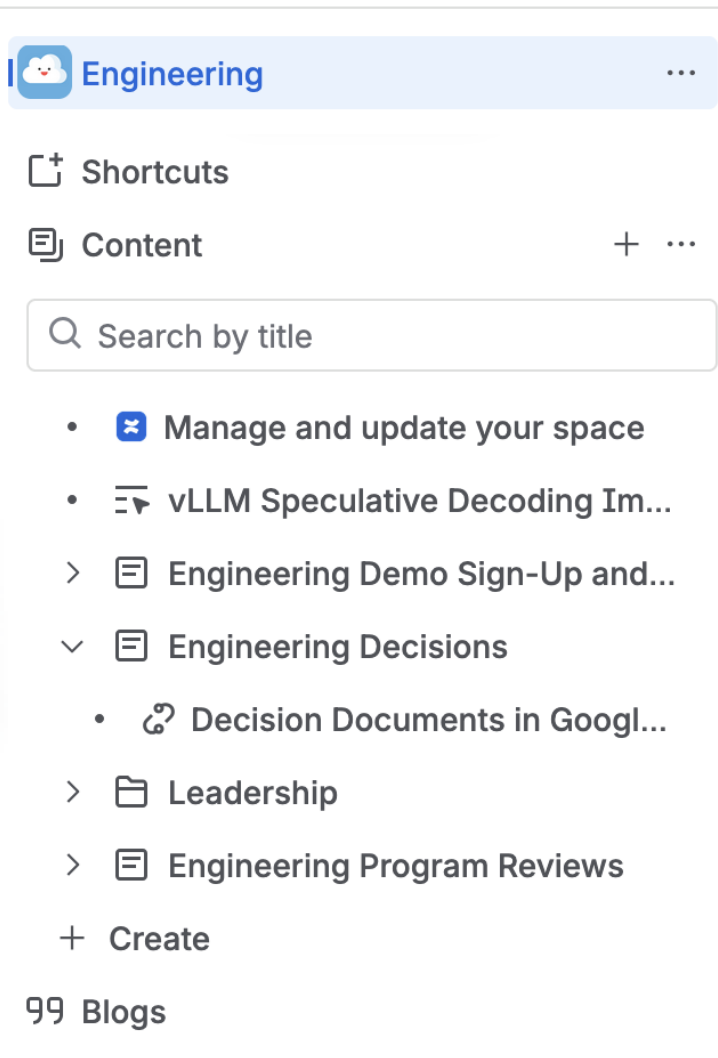
Content isn't large, and is unlikely to expand over time.

Content meant for onboarding should be:

- 1. Searchable - take advantage of Confluence's search so it is easily found
- 2. Independently discoverable - where is the most likely spot for this to be located?

*Still accessible* to other orgs - Engineering-related onboarding, even if useful to IT, should be in Engineering documents, just as IT docs house all-org references for setup.
